

A. Presentation – Super Star Student of the Month Certificates for April, 2015.

Mayor Masiarczyk and the Commission presented Certificates of Recognition to the Super Star Students for the month of April, 2015.

Late arrival, Jaylan Edwards was presented with her Superstar Student award for April, 2015.

B. Presentation of Inductee to the Wall of Fame – Former Commissioner Lucille Wheatley.

Mayor Masiarczyk presented Former Commissioner Lucille Wheatley with a Certificate of Appreciation for being inducted to the City's Wall of Fame.

Former Commissioner Wheatley thanked the person who nominated her, the Committee for recommending the nomination to the Commission, the Commission for approving the nomination and she gave a brief history of how she became a Commissioner. She spoke about her scholarship foundation and the service she has provided to Deltona.

Juanita McNeal a member of Alpha Cappa Alpha Sorority, and Mavis Liddy, Volusia County Councilmember at large Joyce Cusack and Pastor Troy Bradley with Greater Union Baptist Church presented Former Commissioner Wheatley with flowers and gifts to show their appreciation for all she has done for the community.

C. Proclamation – Older Americans Month – May, 2015.

Deputy City Clerk Janet Day read the Proclamation for the record and the Mayor and Commission presented it to Rafael Ramirez with Halifax Health and Cathy Coates with Council on Aging.

D. Proclamation – National Association of Letter Carriers “Stamp Out Hunger” Food.

Mayor Masiarczyk asked if anyone from the Post Office was present, then he read the Proclamation into the record and reminded everyone to make a food donation at their mailbox to be picked up by the letter carrier on Friday, May 8th.

E. Presentation – Florida/Final Mile Race Management, LLC.

Rafael Ramirez with Halifax Health who co-sponsored the 5K Race with the City presented a check for \$6,054.25 to the American Heart Association. This is the 3rd year that Deltona held the event which has been very successful.

F. Presentation – Quarterly Reports of City Advisory Boards/Committees.

2 Mayor Masiarczyk stated the Quarterly Advisory Board reports were all written reports.

3
4 **6. CITY COMMISSION SPECIAL REPORTS:**

5
6 Commissioner Nabicht stated he attended the Firefighters' Pension Board Meeting, in one (1) of the
7 recent ordinance changes a particular group of real estate had been added which is performing
8 extremely well, it has added a considerable amount of money to the plan in the short time it has been
9 there and year to date it is performing at 13.6% and the target is 8% for the overall plan. He
10 attended the Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Meeting and the most significant part of
11 the meeting that pertains to the City was the S.R. 415 to I-95 Connector. The TPO voted
12 unanimously to send a letter of support for that project to Volusia County, the Turnpike Authority
13 and the Expressway Authority.

14
15 Commissioner Herzberg stated she attended the Team Volusia Economic Development Committee
16 meeting; the format of the meeting was changed to every other month so that there will be a hour of
17 networking and an hour meeting and that encompasses all investors to get together and network for
18 the first half hour. It is important that the networking occurs because that provides an opportunity
19 for everyone to talk with other cities, the County and above all the private investors. Also, Team
20 Volusia is a conduit for the film industry in Florida through Enterprise Florida and the State.

21
22 Mayor Masiarczyk recognized Orange City Council Member Ron Saylor and Former Commissioner
23 Barnaby and his wife who were in attendance.

24
25 **7. PUBLIC FORUM – Citizen comments for item not on the agenda.**

26
27 a) Smiley Thurston, 608 Saxon Blvd., Deltona, spoke about the Summer Youth Food Program
28 which has opportunities to participate in the program until the end of the month, grants given out to
29 local cities for programs and Deltona not being one (1) of those cities, and there being grant money
30 available next year for Deltona to apply for.

31
32 b) Richard Jorza, 585 Cavalier Avenue, Deltona, spoke about Section 66-19, #2 and #3, with
33 regards to his truck and trailer which is connected to it, the citation he received to move the trailer to
34 one side of the house or another, the trailer not being recreational but, for his job and is used every
35 day. He continued to describe his property and the time that his trailer is parked at the property.

36
37 Mayor Masiarczyk suggested that Mr. Jorza contact the Acting City Manager to discuss the issue.

38
39 Commissioner Nabicht asked if the action was due to a complaint or to a Code Officer driving by the
40 property and Mr. Jorza replied the Code Officer Ms. Miller stated she was driving by the property.

41
42 c) Mike Williams, 2889 Cottageville Drive, Deltona, spoke about the new City Manager Jane
43 Shang, he is pleased with the selection and confident she will do a good job, as a resident he assured
44 her that she would have his full support behind her and that the National Association for the
45 Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) supports the Commission's selection for City Manager.
46 He is pleased the Commission recognized Former Commissioner Lucille Wheatley but, he was
47 disappointed that other former Commissioners were not present to show their support and that they
48 should have been invited to attend. He reminded everyone of the NAACP Annual Freedom Fund

1 Banquet on June 5th at 6:00 p.m. at New Hope Baptist Church and that Commissioner Smith and her
 2 husband are life members of the NAACP.

 25 Commissioner Herzberg stated on Page 66, Section 2 (c), there are three (3) seasons listed 2015,
 26 2016, 2017 and she requested the Commission only approve the fee schedule for the year 2015 since
 27 there is a new City Manager who the Commission may want to review all the City's fees and
 28 procedures and she does not see locking the City into a designated set of fees per individual for
 29 another two (2) years if the Commission should have a desire to change it or revise some the City's
 30 agreements.

31
 32 **Motion by Commissioner Herzberg, to approve the item only for the 2015 year fee schedule.**

33
 34 **Motion died for lack of a second.**

35
 36 The Commission and staff discussed that agenda items be presented to the Commission in redline
 37 and strikethrough formatting so it is easier to see what the changes are, not being locked in to the
 38 three (3) year fee schedule, staff's meeting with the organizations to come up with an acceptable fee
 39 schedule that each could afford and the fees being a result of that meeting, registration time for year
 40 2016 and not interfering with the registration process, the facility use agreement spells out the terms
 41 and fees and staff also discusses the terms and fees with the organizations so there are no surprises,
 42 honoring the agreements that the City has with organizations, the organizations wanting to insure
 43 that the maximum fee per person was no higher than \$20 per child over a four (4) or five (5) year
 44 period, could the Commission live with a to be announced (tba) number or a subject to change
 45 number, once the agreement is signed it is in affect for one (1) year, and the fee could be discussed at
 46 the time of renewal.

 24 Mayor Masiarczyk opened and closed the public hearing as there were no comments.

 26 **Motion by Commissioner Nabicht, seconded by Vice Mayor Schleicher to approve Ordinance**
 27 **No. 03-2015. rezoning application RZ15-001 Hess Gas Station.**

28
 29 City Attorney Becky Vose read the title of Ordinance No. 03-2015.

30
 31 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELTONA,**
 32 **FLORIDA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 110,**
 33 **SECTION 1101 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR PROPERTY TOTALING**
 34 **APPROXIMATELY 1.1 ACRES LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE**
 35 **INTERSECTION OF COURTLAND BLVD. AND DOYLE ROAD, PROVIDING FOR**
 36 **CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

 42 Ordinance No. 03-2015 was approved at 7:42 p.m.

43
 44 **10. OLD BUSINESS:** None.

 46 **11. NEW BUSINESS:**

47
 48 **A. ADD-ON ITEM: Consideration of proposed City Manager contract.**

1
2 Mayor Masiarczyk stated currently the City is in negotiations with Ms. Shang until the Commission
3 accepts the contract. He thanked the City Attorney for her help on the contract, Ms. Shang has
4 accepted the proposed contract, the position of the Commission is to make a motion to move forward
5 with it and negotiations of the contract were not done in public but, in private.

6
7 **Motion by Commissioner Nabicht, seconded by Commissioner Herzberg to accept the**
8 **contract.**

9
10 Commissioner Soukup expressed his disappointment with the proposed City Manager contract to
11 include the salary of \$150,000 with a raise to \$165,000 in six (6) months and at one (1) year it goes
12 to \$175,000, the \$300,000 in life insurance, five (5) weeks of vacation and 90 days of sick time to
13 start, the \$4,200 in personal mileage, the FRS maximum, up to \$25,000 in moving costs to include
14 two (2) trips to/from Texas, and payment of \$2,000 to be paid for the first six (6) months toward a
15 house payment.

16
17 The Commission discussed the average resident's income being around \$55,000, the position being
18 posted at a salary of \$150,000, being careless with resident's money, the increases in compensation
19 the first year with no evaluation, receiving the contract at 3:00 p.m. which provided no time for
20 Commissioner's to do any research, whether or not the proposed contract was a standard contract,
21 whether City Manager's receive mileage, and in Section 12-Performance where did the date of
22 October 6th come from because it is not six (6) months from the contract date.

23
24 City Attorney Becky Vose stated that the October 6th date was traditionally always the date put in
25 the City Manager agreements and the date is at the beginning of the year so that staff remembered to
26 do it.

27
28 The Commission discussed the words "limited defined" regarding having an outside business, house
29 allowance probably being standard, not being in support of the automatic salary increases, Ms.
30 Miller and Mr. Denny's contracts being the basis for the contract, it was a national search and the
31 City being in competition with other States, the severance being limited to 20 weeks which was a
32 concern of Ms. Shang, Ms. Shang having other applications out with other States, the changes in
33 home values, the sick/vacation credit is to make up for the fact that the City is hamstrung with
34 regards to severance pay, a year severance being common up to a year ago and was standard by
35 Deltona terms and throughout the state, if it is a requirement for someone to move there should be
36 moving expenses, that W.D. Higginbotham should of negotiated the contract or could of had an
37 independent negotiator, the City being without a trained and qualified International City/County
38 Management Association (ICMA) City Manager for the last nine (9) years, Ms. Shang having been
39 an Assistant City Manager, Ms. Shang's experience in Boston and Tampa, having to pay for a top
40 notch City Manager, needing a 5 to 2 vote to terminate a Charter Officer, Ms. Shang's employment
41 being in the Commission's hands, that W.D. Higginbotham should have been involved in the
42 negotiation, moving expenses being standard, Ms. Shang being qualified and she stood out as far as
43 what she had to offer, the Commission taking ownership in the fact there has not been a trained City
44 Manager in 9 years, the termination clause was explained, the contract being in line with other cities
45 of Deltona's size, there being nothing earned in the proposed contract, the cost of living being
46 different in Florida, not being good stewards of the City's money, City Managers coming and going
47 due to the will or lack of will of the Commission, a City Manager being an investment, Ms. Shang
48 being able to move projects forward and make the City better, it being important to Ms. Shang to

1 have the backing of all the Commission, looking at the hiring of Ms. Shang as an investment in the
 2 future and not an expense, Ms. Shang being professional, imagining what a good City Manager can
 3 do, and the City Manager being evaluated daily.

4
 5 Mayor Masiarczyk stated the contract is in negotiations until the Commission accepts it and that Ms.
 6 Shang has agreed and signed the contract as presented.

 24 **14. CITY COMMISSION COMMENTS:**

25
 26 a) Commissioner Smith stated she is still not passed the City Manager's contract and she almost
 27 wants to bring back a motion for reconsideration as she is stuck on the comprehension on the base
 28 salary.

29
 30 b) Commissioner Honaker stated it is the 64th Annual National Day of Prayer on May 7th, there
 31 will be road closures at Courtland and Haulover Blvds. on May 5th and 6th due to the current
 32 stormwater project and to get the word out to the residents to plan alternate routes, Mother's Day is
 33 coming up and in Europe Women's Day is celebrated on March 8th every year in recognition of
 34 women's contributions and he reminded everyone that High School Graduations are on May 30th.

35
 36 c) Commissioner Nabicht stated he was invited to the Community Life Center, he encouraged
 37 everyone to take the tour of the facility and that there is a lot more to it than he thought. The
 38 Community Life Center has an application into the City for funds through the Community
 39 Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds, the group has a lot of good information and records, and
 40 he spoke to the group about the homeless in Deltona but, the group did not see a lot of homeless in
 41 the City which are being tracked. He suggested looking at budgeting to hire someone to take
 42 responsibility of helping to coordinate some of these social service programs that are being run by
 43 the community, churches and other organizations. He believes if the City can partner with the
 44 Community Life Center and other organizations, provide advertising on DeltonaTV and in the
 45 quarterly Newsletter, and lobbying Volusia County for funds which a great deal of is generated by
 46 Deltona whose headquarters are on the East side and that makes it difficult to get some of that
 47 money back for the residents. He suggested having a discussion at a workshop regarding
 48 coordinating with the Community Life Center for social service programs.

1
2 d) Vice Mayor Schleicher stated several residents thanked her for the trees from Arbor Day, she
3 attended the 1st Anniversary of SunRail where Mayor Buddy Dyer held up a sign that said "Next
4 Stop City of DeLand" so there was a push for that location, and she thanked Commissioner Smith
5 for spearheading Relay For Life. She attended two (2) meetings regarding Thornby garden
6 development project, that all the guidelines will be met from historical, educational, recreational and
7 environmental. She hopes to have some presentations around the middle or end of August for
8 everyone to see, there will be a tour of the property on May 15th and she will send invitations out to
9 the Commission. She stated to think of the word "H.E.R.E.", Historical, Environmental,
10 Recreational and Educational.

11
12 e) Commissioner Herzberg asked about the negotiations with the Grant Writer Ms. Brookes and
13 Mr. Baker replied the City can either do a contract with her for specific grants or to be the City's
14 grant writer. He stated he spoke and since he can contract with her for a specific grant, he will
15 address in the new budget year contracting with her as the City's Grant Writer because there was
16 nothing budgeted this budget year for this.

17
18 f) Commissioner Herzberg stated looking at the Flagler/Volusia Continuum of Care, who
19 represents the City, there is never an update, and what involvement does the City have and Mr.
20 Bowley replied the City has been involved for several years, the City partners some with the
21 Neighborhood Center out of DeLand with Susan Clark and given them money through Community
22 Development Block Grant (CDBG) to help fund their efforts, the group has beds and the Homeless
23 Management Information Systems (HMIS) database, and he is a member of the committee but, Mari
24 Leisen attends and represents the City. Commissioner Herzberg suggested once Ms. Shang arrives
25 to schedule a workshop with staff, get a reality of what the City already contribute, how the City is
26 going to participate and a breakdown of the City's participation and funding. She stated in the
27 weekly curtesy report there are listed impoundments that go to Halifax Humane Society every week
28 and she would like to request that those impoundments be divided by the number of dogs and
29 number cats because the City has a grant program through Halifax Humane Society for Trap, Neuter
30 and Release (TNR). The number from the Halifax Humane Society show the City impounded 192
31 cats from January 1st through April 22nd at \$84 per impound for a total of \$16,128. There were
32 kittens impounded that are too young to be fixed, cats with tipped ears are being taken, if the number
33 of cats being impounded is increasing why is the City providing this service to the residents, and the
34 City is impounding more cats than when the program started.

35
36 g) Commissioner Nabicht asked for clarification, the cats are being picked up after going
37 through the program being tipped and neutered and Mr. Baker replied the cats being taken in are
38 from a citizen's personal trap who call staff asking to have a nuisance cat removed or a citizen asks
39 staff to set a trap to remove a nuisance cat and those are the cats staff is taking in. He stated he will
40 have to go more in-depth and go through each case to determine if it was a dog or cat that was
41 impounded.

42
43 h) Commissioner Herzberg stated the City nor the Halifax Humane Society can determine if the
44 program is working or not and the City needs to come up with another program for residents to get
45 their dogs fixed. The City is doing community relations to discuss and find out the situation with a
46 resident and to find out what the nuisance is.

47

1 i) Commissioner Soukup stated he has always been a member of a team his whole life, he is a
2 part of this team, he accepts the decisions made by the Commission, he values everyone who works
3 for the City but, that is not who he was elected by or what he was elected for. He is excited for Ms.
4 Shang to come to the City, the City needs a City Manager, he and Commissioner Nabicht were the
5 Commissioners who added her to the list of finalists, he is disappointed not in who the Commission
6 chose but, what was given away, he accepts the Commission's decision and he wants to move
7 forward.

8
9 j) Mayor Masiarczyk thanked Commissioner Smith and Vice Mayor Schleicher for attending
10 Relay For Life, the scouts came out and painted the helicopter at the Veterans Museum and he felt
11 he could not leave to attend the event, he encouraged everyone to drive by and see the helicopter
12 which was painted by a young Eagle Scout named Cameron Day who should be applauded for his
13 efforts. Victory Over Europe Day (VOE) is this Friday and there will be a ceremony at Veterans
14 Museum at 6:30 p.m. On Memorial Day services will be at 10:00 a.m. at the Deltona Memorial
15 Gardens on Saxon Blvd. and at 2:00 p.m. there will be six (6) large crosses installed with the names,
16 dates, killed in action and country of the eight (8) service members from Southwest Volusia who
17 were killed in action since the Vietnam War.

18
19 k) Commissioner Herzberg asked if there was a workshop on Tuesday, May 26th and Mr. Baker
20 replied there is no workshop planned.

21
22 l) Commissioner Nabicht asked if there was going to be a workshop to discuss getting with Mr.
23 Baker, the transition plan, a list of projects to be prioritized, what the Commission expects in the
24 transition between Mr. Baker and Ms. Shang and he does not care if she is present or not. Mayor
25 Masiarczyk suggested the Commissioners make a list of things they have and a Special meeting
26 could be called if necessary.

A Special Meeting of the Deltona City Commission was held on Monday, May 11, 2015 at the City Hall, 2nd Floor Conference Room, 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida.

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Masiarczyk.

3. PLEDGE TO THE FLAG:

The City Commission and staff said the pledge to the flag.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Mayor Masiarczyk opened the meeting for public comment.

a) Former Commissioner Zenaida Denizac, 2010 Montecito Avenue, Deltona, spoke about her disappointment with the way the City Manager contract came to be, the contract being placed on the agenda at the last minute and having to read it in the newspaper, the public's right to know and be informed and Government in the Sunshine. She spoke about the City Manager's position being advertised from \$130,000 to \$150,000 and if anything outside that number was being negotiated it should have been brought before the Commission for discussion. She discussed that Ms. Shang having never being a City Manager, the state law that changed the amount of severance which can be awarded and going around that intent of the law and compensating the applicant to make up for the lack of severance sending the wrong message. She spoke about doing a national search not meaning that the City has to pay a salary like New York City, the candidates being aware of the salary range and still applying for the job, there being no performance measures built into the contract, being upset at how the negotiations and the contract were handled, the public should have been informed and provided the option to express their opinions and she wanted to make her voice heard.

b) Larry DeMatteo, 255 Barry Drive, Deltona, asked if how public comments are heard at public meetings had changed and he spoke about getting public comment after the Commission had made a decision on the City Manager position, the contract being outrageous, the salary increase at six (6) months without an evaluation and in general everything in the contract being way above what Deltona is and can afford. He stated any Commissioner that agrees with the approved contract should get out of politics as they are doing nothing by running the City into the ground and do not care about the residents or the City.

c) Former Commissioner Barnaby, 2242 East Fairbanks Drive, Deltona, stated it was his understanding that the search firm was supposed to do all of the negotiations and he asked for an explanation as to why that was not done, wanting the new City Manager to start off on the right foot, it being awkward that the contract is being discussed at this workshop after the fact, his disappointment in not seeing anyone in the room from the search firm, doing things with integrity and the citizens demanding it, having a good working relationship with the business community, the Commission being professional and if the Commission makes a mistake owning up to it.

d) Larry Kent, 235 River Village Drive, DeBary, spoke about spending a lot of time following the process, not everyone being happy with the contract, the Commission being able to terminate the City Manager, Ms. Shang being the best candidate for the job, the City losing two (2) candidates during the interview process, the City working within its time constraints, being excited about Ms. Shang coming onboard, he encouraged everyone to watch the skype interviews, the pay range being \$130,000 to \$150,000 but, the Commission had stated it knew there was a possibility that the City would need to pay more for a qualified City Manager.

e) Silvia Barnaby, 2242 East Fairbanks Drive, Deltona, stated she was present for some of the interviews, the Commission making a good decision by choosing Ms. Shang, an evaluation being needed and the evaluation not being done at the appropriate time (October), the City Manager earning a raise in salary based on an evaluation, letting Ms. Shang know she is valued and that she needs to prove herself.

f) Mike Putkowski, 2736 Courtland Blvd., Deltona, stated he had concerns with Ms. Shang's salary, the automatic raises, the vacation and sick time being available immediately, Ms. Shang proving herself and paying her dues, this being the fifth City Manager in the 10 years he has lived in the City and people having to earn raises including Ms. Shang.

g) Patsy Dockery, 2749 Thornberry Court, Deltona, stated Ms. Shang's contract is "a whole lot of plush," no real economic development has taken place in the six (6) years she has lived in the City, Commissioner Soukup speaking up about the tax payers, a list of things Ms. Shang will be providing the City in return for her contract, what are Ms. Shang's goals and vision for Deltona, she questioned what Ms. Shang put on the table that makes her worth what the Commission has agreed to pay her, if Ms. Shang were to be fired she walks away with a large paycheck and having a choreographed Commission meeting.

Mayor Masiarczyk closed the meeting for public comment.

4. BUSINESS:

A. Discussion re: City Manager Contract.

Mayor Masiarczyk stated he called the Special Commission Meeting without any input from any other member of the Commission because of the article in the newspaper and several other issues, he felt it would be wise to air discussions he had with Ms. Shang. The Commission directed himself and the City Attorney to negotiate the contract which was done over the phone. The first question asked of Ms. Shang was if she had a contract to which she said no so a former established City Manager contract which was used in the past was sent to Ms. Shang. This meeting is not to change

anything, the Commission has hired Ms. Shang as its new City Manager and unless directed otherwise her first day will be June 1st. There are conspiracy theories as to why this meeting was being held but, it was only because he cannot talk to the members of the Commission all at once unless the Commission is in a public meeting. Ms. Shang watched the meeting on Monday night in its entirety, she wants to be here, she is looking forward to working with the Commission and she wants to work with a unified Commission. There are some concerns regarding travel expenditures but, she has already looked at it and made some adjustments even though it does not change the contract. He stated the statement Ms. Shang made to him which made him feel comfortable was "I would not spend a dime of the City of Deltona's money if I would not be willing to spend my own money to make the move." He spoke with Ms. Shang this morning, he told her he had called this meeting to air and to discuss any concerns, she is totally on board, she is ready to come and she has taken actions to move forward.

City Attorney Becky Vose stated she spoke with Ms. Shang after the meeting on Monday night, she was concerned that some people did not have the time to look into the contract, to analyze it and make their comments known. Ms. Shang is in favor of having this meeting so everyone could express their concerns because she wanted it to be discussed, looked at and any concerns to be put to bed. Ms. Shang does not want anything hanging over her head once she starts and she is going to be very busy lady. Mrs. Vose suggested that the Commission talk about Ms. Shang's agreement and that Ms. Shang asked the Commission to fully air any concerns they may have.

Vice Mayor Schleicher discussed that the City Charter requires an evaluation be done in October and that the consultant would have offered to negotiate the contract if the Commission had asked.

Commissioner Soukup discussed that an evaluation may be done in October but, that an evaluation has nothing to do with Ms. Shang's automatic raises, that after a year Ms. Shang will be in the top three (3) highest paid City Managers in the County, being 100% behind Ms. Shang, the concerns not having to do with Ms. Shang, the residents paying the City Manager's salary and being guaranteed five (5) weeks of vacation and 96 hours of sick time with an accrual rate as the top employees of the City.

Commissioner Smith discussed Ms. Shang not availing herself of travel expenditures, that negotiations should have been done in the spirit of the Sunshine Law and the contract being an add-on item to the agenda without notice to the public.

Mrs. Vose stated one (1) of the reasons for this meeting is to air concerns in the spirit of the Sunshine Law, Ms. Shang understood the hurry to make a decision as she had applications into other cities, the City had two (2) candidates fall out of the process and did not want that to happen again, the final information from Ms. Shang was not received until 3:00 p.m. on Monday, and it may have been better to put off the approval of the contract but, Ms. Shang may have gotten another offer.

Commissioner Herzberg discussed the Commission approving the wording in the job announcement, the compensation being in range with other cities and the motion for the Mayor and Mrs. Vose to negotiate the contract. She stated she sent the contract to W.D. Higginbotham, she provided historical information regarding previous contract negotiations which always included an elected official and the City Attorney and/or City Manager. She stated Ms. Shang by far is the most qualified, she provided a brief history of her qualifications and she talked about the compensation being at the high end.

Motion by Commissioner Herzberg, seconded by Commissioner Nabicht to re-confirm the contract for Jane Shang.

Commissioner Nabicht discussed the Commission not utilizing W.D. Higginbotham to negotiate the contract and other things in that agreement with the consultant that the Commission also did not choose to utilize and Ms. Shang's contract being a good contract. He quoted language that Former Commissioner Barnaby would say in meetings: "we need some greatness here in Deltona," "we need to bring some great things here," "the head of the snake has to be great," "the head of the machine has to be greatness" and that those things come with a price. He stated he is proud of hiring Jane Shang and her salary being an incentive for her to achieve and bring good things to the City. He will hold her to greatness and he will make it his number one (1) priority to see that the City is getting every dollar out of Ms. Shang that the City is giving her. He stated Ms. Shang brings integrity and respect that the City needs in the County, the City having talked about being the "big dog" and now showing it is the "big dog." He discussed Ms. Shang leading the County out of its transportation problems, Deltona being the leader in transportation and Ms. Shang leading that effort not only for the City but, the County and if she does not produce then he will make the motion to terminate her employment.

Mayor Masiarczyk stated he had spoken with Frank O'Dea, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Director Transportation Development, and he mentioned that he knew Ms. Shang and worked with her in the past with some projects on the West side of the State.

Former Commissioner Denizac clarified that the City Charter does not mention that the City Manager shall be evaluated in October and Mayor Masiarczyk replied that is correct, it is in the contract.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:15 p.m.


