The City of Deltona is currently looking for one (1) individual interested in serving on the City's Economic Development Advisory Board for the remainder of a term to expire on May 31, 2017. Members elected to the Economic Development Advisory Board will be full voting members appointed by the City Commission.

Individuals appointed to this Board serve a remainder of a two (2) year term in a non-paid capacity. The purpose of this Board is to:

- 1) Advise the City Commission on issues and programs involving economic development;
- 2) The Board recommendations shall be advisory only;
- 3) The Board shall issue a draft written five-year plan setting forth the strategies, goals, and procedural steps necessary to actively seek new business and support the expansion of existing business that will enhance the quality of life in the community; and
- 4) The Board shall explore funding sources for economic development.

Board meetings are held the second Friday of each month at 3:30 p.m. in the City Hall 2nd Floor Conference Room, 2345 Providence Blvd. Appointments to this Board will be made by the City Commission in accordance with the laws and ordinances of the City. Individuals appointed to this Board must be a resident of the City of Deltona, a business owner, or commercial landowner within the City limits.
