BASIC LIFE SUPPORT FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers is a video-based, instructor-led course that teaches both single rescuer and team basic life support.



This course trains participants to promptly recognize several life threatening emergencies, give high quality chest compressions, deliver

appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED.

BLS for Healthcare Providers teaches skills using the American Heart Association's proven Practice-While-Watching technique, which allows instructors to observe students, and provide feedback and guide students' acquisition of skills.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

This course is for healthcare professionals who need to know how to perform CPR, as well as other lifesaving skills, in a wide variety of in-hospital and out-of-hospital settings.

COURSE CONTENT

The BLS for HCP course includes the following:

- ◆ Key changes in basic life support, reflecting the new science from the 2010 American Heart Association Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care
- ◆ Critical concepts of high quality CPR
- ◆ The American Heart Association Chain of Survival
- ◆ 1 Rescuer CPR and AED for adult, child, and infant
- ◆ 2 Rescuer CPR CPR and AED for adult, child and infant
- ◆ Differences between adult, child, and infant rescue techniques
- ◆ Bag-mask techniques for adult, child, and infant
- ◆ Rescue breathing for adult, child, and infant
- ◆ Relief of choking for adult, child, and infant
- ◆ CPR with an advanced airway

BLS FOR HCP COURSE INFORMATION

- ◆ **Class Duration:** 4 hours
- ◆ **Cost:** \$50.00
- ◆ **Registration includes:** Student handbook, mask, and a 2-year certification card

BLS FOR HCP RENEWALS

The BLS for HCP renewal course is for those healthcare professionals that already have a certification card and need it renewed.

- ◆ **Class Duration:** 2 hours
- ◆ **Cost:** \$35.00
- ◆ **Registration includes:** 2-year certification card
- ◆ Students must register in advance
- ◆ Payment is required before class

Your CPR certification card *must* be current in order to take a renewal course. If your CPR card is expired, you must take the regular BLS for HCP course.
