## What is RCMP?

The Residential Construction Mitigation Program (RCMP) is a grant funded program to increase the wind resistance of homes.

### WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA?

- ⇒ Single family home
- ⇒ Built prior to 2002
- ⇒ Site built home (no manufactured homes)
- ⇒ No unpermitted work
- ⇒ No outstanding liens or judgments
- ⇒ Primary residence (must be homesteaded)
- ⇒ Located within The City of Deltona

### What are some of the participation requirements?

- ⇒ Completed, signed and dated application.
- ⇒ Required documentation, including financial information to be submitted at time of application submittal.
- ⇒ Be available to keep scheduled appointments with city staff, contractors and inspectors.
- ⇒ Sign and return all requested documentation on a timely basis.


### WHAT DOES IT COVER?

The intent of this mitigation program is to retrofit and reinforce the envelope of a house; such as the roof, soffit, vents, doors, and shutters.

Some common retrofit/reinforcement efforts include gable end bracing, hurricane straps, shuttering of windows and sliding glass doors.

This program DOES NOT cover items such as HVAC, septic systems, drywall, plumbing, electrical wiring, wood rot, or termite damage.
