HEARTSAVER CPR AED

Healthcare CPR AED is a classroom, video-based, instructor-led course that teaches adult CPR and AED use, as well as how to relieve choking on an adult. This course teaches skills with AHA's research-proven Practice-While-Watching (PWW) technique, which allows instructors to observe the students, provide feedback and guide the students' learning of skills.

COURSE INFORMATION

COURSE CONTENT

This course will teach you how to recognize and treat life-threatening emergencies, including cardiac arrest and choking. You will also learn to recognize the warning signs of a heart attack and stroke in adults and signs of breathing difficulty in children. This class also instructs each student on AED (automated external defibrillator) operation.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

Individuals who do not work in the healthcare field but are occupationally required to, or desire to, have CPR knowledge and skills, such as:

HEARTSAVER FIRST AID

Heartsaver First Aid is a classroom, video-based, instructor-led course that teaches students critical skills to respond to and manage an emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services (EMS) arrives. Students learn skills such as how to treat bleeding, sprains, broken bones, shock and other first aid emergencies.



COURSE CONTENT

First Aid is the immediate care given to a injured or suddenly ill person. It is a temporary assistance that is rendered until competent medical care, if needed, arrives and takes over.

This is a basic course that will concentrate on the first five minutes of care.

Properly applied first aid can save lives, reduce recovery time, and quite possibly be the difference between temporary disability or lifelong disability for a victim.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

Individuals who require or desire elementary first aid knowledge and skills with a focus on adults, children, or both, including:

- Adult residential care personnel
- Child care workers and babysitters
- Teachers
- Parents
- School bus drivers
