11. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Consideration of appointment of seven (7) members to the Economic Development Advisory Board.

After discussion, the Commission voted unanimously to confirm the Commission's re-appointments of all seven (7) members with a term to expire on May 31, 2017 and the appointments of the following alternate members: Christine Peacock, Eduardo Moscarella, Carlos Valderrama, and Glenn Woodley.

B. Consideration of appointment of seven (7) members to the William S. Harvey Deltona Scholarship Advisory Board.

After discussion, the Commission voted unanimously to confirm the Commission's re-appointment of five (5) members (Walter Dawson, Cristina Raimundo, Steve Lightbody, Harry Meeks and Lori Burbank) and the additional appointments of Sandra Dillard (Mayor Masiarczyk's appointment) and Johnny Inthachack (Commissioner Smith's appoint) for a term to expire on May 31, 2017.
