**CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA  
SPECIAL CITY COMMISSION MEETING  
MONDAY, JULY 21, 2014**

A Special Meeting of the Deltona City Commission was held on Monday, July 21, 2014 in the City Hall Commission Chambers, 2345 Providence Blvd. Deltona, Florida.

**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor John Masiarczyk, Sr.

**3. PLEDGE TO THE FLAG:**

Mayor Masiarczyk led everyone in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

**4. BUSINESS:**

**A. Public Hearing - Resolution No. 2014-15, Establishing the tentative proposed millage rate for the levy of ad valorem taxes for FY 2014/2015.**

Mayor Masiarczyk opened and closed the public hearing as there were no public comments.

**Motion by Commissioner Nabicht, seconded by Vice Mayor Herzberg to approve Resolution No. 2014-15, adopting the tentative proposed millage rate for the levy of ad valorem taxes for FY 2014/2015 at 7.9900 mills.**

Commissioner Barnaby stated he objected to the motion, he wants the public to know there has been an increase in property values and the proposed millage rate would result in an increase in taxes which he strongly opposes and he proposes to roll back the millage rate to 7.4 mills.

1 The Commission discussed what the difference in revenue would be between 7.99 mills and 7.4  
2 mills which is in the \$800,000 to \$900,000 range, now not being the time to lower the millage  
3 rate, staff providing a chart which would show the difference in a home's value with both  
4 millage rates, not lowering the millage rate until staff has a chance to look at the numbers that  
5 come in from the State from sales tax revenues and communication revenues and anything else  
6 coming in before the millage rate is lowered, the proposed millage rate being what the property  
7 appraiser puts on the TRIM notice and the Commission always having the option of lowing the  
8 millage rate later, many families struggling to put food on the table or buy school supplies,  
9 having the opportunity to put money back in the resident's pockets, Interim City Manager  
10 candidates mentioning the City has a high millage rate, being more conservative with regards to  
11 the millage rate, it being better to set the millage rate high now and possibly lowering it later, the  
12 State and property appraiser's numbers received are only preliminary, and there being several  
13 increases in the proposed budget like the Volusia County Sheriff's Office (VCSO) contract,  
14 health insurance and lower gas taxes coming in.

15  
16 Vice Mayor Herzberg explained the millage rate based on her tax bill and what it equated to.

17  
18 Commissioner Barnaby stated the City Manager's proposal of the FY 2014/2015 budget is based  
19 on a millage rate of 7.99, this proposed millage rate is the same as what was levied FY  
20 2013/2014 and he quoted from staff "reflects a 7.6% increase" from the roll back rate. He stated  
21 he is absolutely and totally against the proposed millage rate of 7.99.

23 Mayor Masiarczyk read the title of Resolution No. 2014-15.
