SENIOR ADVISORY SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING

A Regular Meeting of the Senior Advisory Sub-Committee was held on Monday, July 23, 2012 at the City Hall Commission Chambers Kitchen at 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida.

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Janet Deyette, Chair.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. Minutes:

1. Meeting – April 23, 2012.

Motion by Mary Micelli, seconded by Beverly Pellon to adopt the minutes of the Regular Senior Advisory Sub-Committee meeting of April 23, 2012. There was no discussion. The motion was unanimously approved.

4. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

The following flyers/information were distributed to the members: National Night Out; Simulcast.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT:

There were no members from the public present for this meeting.

6. OLD BUSINESS:

A. Community Expo Wrap Up:

Staff informed the Sub-Committee that a total of 230 guests attended this year's expo, which had just fallen short of last years Ability Fair's attendance. Vendors and guests alike provided positive feedback via the completed surveys. Marge Miller and Janet Deyette discussed the increase in

1 vendor variety. Mr. Moore explained that the survey reflects that ages 40-60 were the largest age
2 group seeking health information.

11 **A. Senior Breakfast:**

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13 Mr. Moore suggested that the lower attendance is due to the overall lack of discretionary income
14 within the community. The breakfast was successful and was well received by all that attended.
15 There were no issues mentioned by the volunteers or the guests.

17 Mr. Moore is supporting this event to continue for another year, suggesting the group focus on
18 ways to reach more of the senior community. Staff and the Sub-Committee agreed to pre-sell
19 tickets for next year's breakfast.

21 The Senior Advisory Sub-Committee suggested that leftover food be donated to a local charity.
22 Staffed agreed and asked the Sub-Committee to research charities to receive the food donation
23 next year.

25 Timing of the breakfast was discussed. The Sub-Committee will provide staff with a
26 recommendation of the best time to host the breakfast at the next scheduled meeting.

28 **8. DIRECTOR COMMENTS:**

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30 Mr. Moore updated the Sub-Committee on the jazz concert that had been rescheduled for July 11th,
31 stating that it was well attended. Beverly Pellon then asked if flyers could be distributed during the
32 concerts for upcoming events. Mr. Moore will review the possibility but is also concerned with
33 increasing the amount of litter on the ground. Rose Miller mentioned that a majority of the expo and
34 breakfast surveys returned suggested that the newspaper is the most successful in advertising events.

36 Beverly Pellon inquired about the date of the Halloween Ball. Janet Deyette and Mary Micelli stated
37 that the city is not hosting a Halloween Ball this year. Mr. Moore confirmed that the ball was
38 canceled for this year. He explained that seniors attend the Halloween celebration at Dewey Boster
39 and that the breakfast accommodates more seniors in our community than the Halloween Ball.

41 Mr. Moore suggested that the Sub-Committee focus their creativity on Santa's North Pole.

43 **9. MEMBERS COMMENTS:**

45 a. Beverly Pellon recommended the Deltona Alliance Church for the food donation, stating
46 that they feed the hungry every Monday.

- 1 b. Mary Micelli suggested placing a donation box at the Santa's North Pole. Mr. Moore said
2 that suggestion will need to be looked into.

4 c. Janet Deyette stated that the food at the breakfast was great.
5
6 d. Rose Miller mentioned that she had recently met a home bound senior who was not aware
7 of the Senior Center in Deltona. She expressed concern as to how many other seniors do
8 not know what the City has to offer them. Rose Miller suggested that the Sub-Committee
9 schedule a trip or a fashion show. Staff will look into those suggestions at a later time.
10 There is concern with the expense.
