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A Regular Meeting of the Senior Advisory Sub-Committee was held on Monday, October 22, 2012 at the City Hall Commission Chambers Kitchen at 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida.

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1. CALL TO ORDER:

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The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by Rose Miller, Vice Chair.

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3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

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A. Minutes:

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1. Meeting – July 23, 2012.

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Motion by Mary Micelli, seconded by Marge Miller to adopt the minutes of the Regular Senior Advisory Sub-Committee meeting of July 23, 2012. There was no discussion. The motion was unanimously approved.

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4. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

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The following flyers/information were distributed to the members: Spooktacular; Friday Nite Flix & Fun “Madagascar”; Deltona’s 50th Celebration & Sock Hop.

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5. PUBLIC COMMENT:

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There were no members from the public present for this meeting.

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6. OLD BUSINESS:

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A. Discussion of “Without Walls”:

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Mary Micelli presented research she had collected over the internet on the program, explaining that the program is pretty extensive and would consume a large amount volunteer time to assist just a few

1 seniors. Mary Micelli mentioned that, Meals on Wheels and Voltram are available to seniors.

3 Marge Miller stated that a surprisingly large amount of her customers are able to use common
4 computer programs that are available at no cost.

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6 Staff suggested the Senior Advisory Sub-Committee members focus on organizations and programs
7 that could to assist older seniors within the City of Deltona.

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9 Members suggested setting up a social hour for seniors to gather such as a “Tea Party”, with the
10 intention of them establishing friendships. Rose Miller mentioned a Saturday; early-afternoon
11 event would accommodate seniors whose caretaker works during the week. Members suggested
12 keeping it simple and hosting it once a month, giving seniors something to look forward to such as
13 the teen movie night.

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17 **A. Discussion of Santa’s North Pole:**

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19 Staff is in the process of completing the flyer and will email it to the Senior Advisory Sub-
20 Committee for assistance in promoting the event. Staff informed the members that the time had
21 been reconsidered due to last year’s attendance more than doubling the prior years.

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23 The members asked if Walgreens was on board to participate. Staff mentioned that there will be
24 discussion of Walgreens participating and/or CVS depending on availability and the package
25 offered to the public.

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27 Staff and the Senior Advisory Sub-Committee developed a volunteer schedule, for decorating
28 Santa’s North Pole.

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30 Members suggested the idea of adding an additional attraction, such as a balloon artist.

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32 **B. Discussion on development of an Arts & Crafts Fair:**

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34 Members suggested that seniors in general tend to construct handmade items and/or crafts and that
35 an Arts & Crafts Fair could benefit the community as a whole. Suggestions were presented about
36 hosting it in November on a Sunday afternoon from 11-3pm. Rose Miller said people would
37 attend looking for holiday gifts. Members suggested charging the vendors a fee to set up and
38 keeping admission free for the public.

8 held? He commented on how successful it was last year.

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15 **10. NEXT MEETING DATE:**


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17 The next meeting of the Senior Advisory Sub-Committee is tentatively scheduled for Monday,


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22 There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
