ELECTION TIME HAS COME TO THE CITY OF Deltona. Voters are encouraged to make their voices heard and head to the polls on Nov. 2 to vote for candidates for state, local, county and city offices. Oct. 4 is the deadline to register to vote in the General Election. For information on how to register or to locate voting precincts visit, [volusia.org/elections](http://volusia.org/elections).

Early voting will be from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Oct. 18 through 30. The Deltona Regional Library, 2150 Eustace Ave., is one of the locations for early voting.

Here in Deltona, City Commission offices for Mayor, as well as District 3 and District 5 will be decided. John Masiarczyk and David Santiago are running for Mayor. Heidi Herzberg and Heather Joy Mitchell are running for District 3 City Commission and Janet Deyette (incumbent) and Fred Lowry are running for District 5.



## Fire Station construction underway

In August, contractors for the new Fire Station 65 (Howland Boulevard) were on site pouring the cement footer walls for the 12,000 square foot building. The new station which boasts three vehicle bays and a training room will be LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified. After three years of planning, the station should open in April 2011. The station will also bring much needed coverage to this area of Deltona.

## Spooktacular comes Oct. 29-30 to Dewey O. Boster

## Fire Department demonstrates importance of Safety at Annual event

The Deltona Fire Department will be hosting their 26th Annual Safety Day from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., Oct. 3 at City Hall, 2345 Providence Blvd.

Numerous safety agencies from the City of Deltona, County & State agencies are expected to participate. Both static displays and demonstrations will highlight this year's event including the posting of colors by the Fire Department Honor Guard, a firematics demonstration by the Fire Department Explorer Post, an auto extrication demonstration, and demonstrations by the Volusia County Sheriff's Office, Deltona and State Fire Marshall's Offices and more.

We will also have a traditional "wash down" and blessing to accept the Fire Department's newest additions to their fleet; a fire engine and brush truck. Information booths will be provided by Fire, Emergency Medical Services and Life Safety, by VCSO/Deltona, by the Fire Department Explorer Post, by the Citizen Emergency Response Team (CERT), Code Enforcement Services/Animal Control, Division of Forestry, Fire Department Honor Guard, by the Deltona High School Health Academy and various City departments.

# Season's Greetings from Sheriff's Office

AS WE APPROACH THE HOLIDAY Season, the Sheriff's Office would like to remind residents of some simple safety tips to protect your home and valuables from the "Grinch."

- Always park in well lit areas.
- Be aware of your surroundings as you approach your vehicle and have your keys in hand.
- Keep your vehicle doors locked.
- Remove valuable items such as presents, purses, computers, navigation systems, loose change and cameras from your vehicle.
- Make sure your home doors and windows are locked and secured at all times.
- Do not place presents in areas of your home that are visible from outside.
- Install an alarm system on your home.
- Remove or trim hedges and bushes that can provide hiding areas.
- Install motion lights around the perimeter of your home.

The Volusia County Sheriff's Office offers free home security surveys to Deltona residents and are also

## Flu shots available through Deltona Fire Department

The Fire Department will administer flu shots from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday and from 9 a.m. to noon, Saturdays at the Deltona Fire Station 61, 1685 Providence Blvd.

The cost is \$25 per person. Cash, check, Visa and MasterCard are accepted. The only insurance accepted is Medicare Part B. This year's vaccine will include 3 strains, influenza A, influenza B and H1N1 in it. Also remember we only use the vaccine that has the dead virus in it. We do not provide any live vaccines. Flu shots are not available for those under 18 or anyone who is pregnant. Anyone in these categories should contact their primary care physician to obtain a shot.

The Fire Department is pleased to be able to offer residents access to quick and affordable influenza vaccines administered by licensed insured professionals. The influenza vaccine is the common flu vaccine, which the National Center for Disease Control recommends once a year.

In order to try and prevent the spread of germs and the flu, make sure you cover your cough and sneezes with a tissue or your sleeve, not your hands. Hand washing is the best way to prevent germs from spreading.



