Boster Sports Complex, 1200 Saxon Blvd. (Parents: DON'T BE LATE.) Our Bunny starts the activities on time! EGGstravaganza is the fastest annual event conducted by the City. The egg "hunting" typically lasts just over 10 minutes. It is the festivities and entertainment that continue until noon that keep all the kids interested.

The egg hunting is for children ages 2 to 10. "Hunters" will be divided into three age categories and should bring their own baskets for gathering eggs. Eggs will be loaded with candy, small toys and some will be specially marked for prizes.
