August 18, 2011—Deltona Parks & Recreation is offering a trip for area adults to ride in a chartered bus to Winter Park for an after of culture and fun.

Adults (ages 18 and older) are invited to Go Out & About to the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art, Winter Park, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Sept. 20. The Museum has the world's most comprehensive collection of works by Louis Comfort Tiffany. The collection includes jewelry, pottery, paintings, art glass, leaded glass windows and lamps and the chapel interior the artist designed for the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago. The Museum's holdings also include a major collection of American art pottery and representative collections of late 19th and early 20th century American paintings, graphics and decorative art.

Buses will depart from the Deltona Community Center, 980 Lakeshore Dr. Bring your own lunch or dine at the Panera Bread Company or the Brandy Wine Deli. Both are reasonably priced and located adjacent to the Museum. Space is limited to the first 52 adults to respond. The cost is \$20 and includes transportation, museum admission and a guided tour.
