City of Deltona Invites Public to Attend Energy Wise Seminars

October 10, 2011— The City of Deltona and Volusia County will conduct a series of at least 6 seminars dedicated to showing residents how to save money through energy conservation. Staff with the Volusia County Extension office will conduct the sessions, coordinated through the City of Deltona.

The topics of the seminars will include trees to conserve energy, winterizing your home, landscaping to conserve energy, and water conservation in and around the home, among others. A majority of the energy conservation seminars will take place in the Scrub Jay Auditorium, at the Deltona Regional Library at 2150 Eustace Avenue, and will begin at 3:30pm. The first session is scheduled for Friday November 4th, and will cover how to decorate your house for the holidays and still save energy dollars.

Because of limited seating, the public is encouraged to pre-register for the seminars, and people can send in their name and contact information to energy@deltonafl.gov. People can also register in person at the Deltona Regional Library. As an added incentive, registrants will receive a coupon redeemable for an energy-efficient light bulb at each seminar they attend. The coupon is for up to \$10.00 off the purchase of CFL or LED lightbulbs.
