City of Deltona Repealing Outdoor Burn Ban

June 11, 2012 – Effective Tuesday June 12th 2012 the City of Deltona Fire Department repealed its outdoor burn ban issued this past April 10th. Recent rains have significantly lowered the drought index to a moderate range of 300-400, which previously was at critical indexes just weeks ago. The threat of wild fires to the residents and visitors of the City of Deltona has been reduced due to the rain.

Although the outdoor burn ban has been repealed, any and all non-cooking outdoor burning must still receive an outdoor burning permit. All residents are encouraged to practice wild fire safety during all outdoor activities and to prepare their property against the threat of wildfires. Also, the setting of fires to brush or forest, unless authorized by the Florida Department of Forestry, is considered a violation of the law, and is punishable by a fine, imprisonment, or a combination of both.
