City of Deltona Schedules Demolition of Second Uninhabitable House

April 11, 2016—The City of Deltona is continuing with its campaign to demolish houses that have been declared unsafe structures. The wrecking ball will next swing this Wednesday April 13th at 9:00am.

Its target is a 1600 square foot size house located at 1182 Fountainhead. The structure has been unoccupied since 2014 and in that time, has developed structural weaknesses, especially in the roof. After a period, the roof collapsed in several areas of the house.

The demolition of abandoned and condemned houses is one of the phases of the City's Beautification Campaign. The program kicked off on February 18th with the tear-down of a burned out house on Covington. There are three other houses that have been declared unsafe, and are scheduled to be demolished within the next 30 days... they are 847 Crawford, 3121 Blaine, and 1195 Acorn.
