May 2, 2016—The City of Deltona along with Swim With Becky and Friends, LLC, invites the public to WADE Day at the Deltona City Hall this Saturday May 7th. WADE (Water And Drowning Education) Day starts at 11:00am with demonstrations and displays in the City Hall Courtyard, and continues until 3:00pm.

The Deltona Fire Department will conduct First Aid classes, taught by a certified trainer beginning at 11:15am. The 15 minute long classes are scheduled at 11:45am, 1:15pm, 1:45pm, 2:15pm and 2:45pm. Those interested in the First Aid classes can sign up at the event. The Deltona Fire Department will also have an EMT unit and water rescue unit on display.

Attendees will see demonstrations and exhibits from SafeKids Volusia/Flagler, Making Change 4 Drowning Prevention, Pinch-a-Penny, Florida Department of Health, the Volusia County NDPA, the Four Townes YMCA, SCS, and Team Kareem Memorial Foundation. The Volusia County Sheriff's Office will have safety items on display as well as its Command Center Trailer. And the COPS will provide fingerprint IDs for children who attend WADE Day.
